



1. USE ENOUGH LIGHT

Lighting makes a big difference in your videos. To make the most out of your recording, get the right amount of light:

- Put the light/ light source in front of you.
- Avoid having the light source behind or above you.
- Avoid direct sunlight or harsh lighting as it may be overpowering (indoor recording is best).







2. USE A NEUTRAL BACKGROUND

Ensure that your background is clean and clear for your video. Before filming:

- Choose a neutral background.
- **Remove distracting elements** in the background *the focus should be on you*.
- Where possible, **use a backdrop**.
- Avoid casting your shadow in the backrgound.







43. SET YOUR DEVICE HORIZONTALLY

Whether you decide to film using your phone, tablet, laptop, or camera, ensure that:

- Your device is **horizontal/landscape**.
- Your device is stable use a tripod if possible. Alternatively, lean your device against something stable.
- Your device is straight and not slanted.



4. OPTIMISE YOUR DEVICE

Quality is key! To ensure your device is optimised, be sure to check if:

- The audio settings are of a high quality. Make you can hear yourself clearly.
- The camera settings is at it's highest quality.
- The camera lens is clean. Wipe the lens gently if not.






5. POSITION YOURSELF EFFECTIVELY

You are the focus of the video, and the best way to position yourself is to:

- Sit or stand comfortably.
- Keep your back straight and shoulders relaxed.
- **Centre yourself** on the screen to ensure that you are in the middle and there is enough space at the edges.
- Stay at eye level do not film from a low or high angle.







6. HAVE A TEST RUN

You are almost ready to record. Once you're all set up, be sure to:

- Write a script if you need to.
- **Practice** go over what you want to say in the video.
- Asses your test run if you are happy with it, then you're all done.




7. RECORD YOUR VIDEO

It's time to record your video. Remember to:

- Start speaking a few seconds after you start filming and give a few seconds before ending the video.
- Speak clearly and don't rush.
- Take a deep breath.
- Smile!
